Call for Applications

The Ordered Liberty School in Central Europe is a joint collaboration of the Ordered Liberty Program at the University of Louisville, (UofL) and Hungary's Ludovika University of Public Service, Faculty of Public Governance and International Studies (LUPS).

Each summer, law professors from the United States and Hungary and – this year – from France gather in Budapest to offer courses centered around freedom of speech in the new media era. The Ordered Liberty School in Central Europe strives to help students to identify the right arrangements of justice, order, and freedom in their own respective nations. This year, professors of the University Paris Saclay join our programme to enlarge the scope of the summer school.

There is no participation fee for the summer classes. Accommodation for not Budapest resident students are guaranteed free of charge. Moreover breakfast, lunch and entry tickets are also covered by the Ludovika University of Public Service. The summer classes will be held in presence at the campus of University of Public Service (Budapest) without online retransmission, in English language.

How to apply

Please apply by sending an English motivation letter (2000-3000 character) and a detailed CV to Mrs. Borbála Telek-Huszár, huszar.borbála@uni-nke.hu. The email's subject should mention "Motivation letter". Please do not send any other documents. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. From the United States only students of Louis D. Brandeis School of Law (University of Louisville) may enroll. They must enroll through their institution.

The deadline for applying is **15 May, 2025, 24:00 (CET).** Applicants will be notified of the results by May 31, 2025.

A strong command of English is required for participating.
